We are extremely grateful to our volunteer knitters and sewers for the time and effort taken in making baby clothing and blankets.

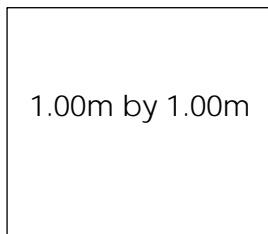
## Important Notes

- Unfortunately, we cannot use garments made from unapproved patterns in our special care nurseries but are happy to take them in our hospital shops to raise funds for research.

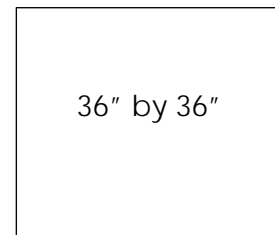

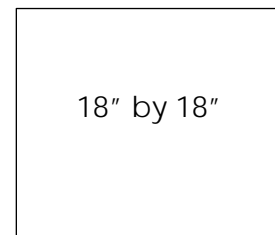
## Wrap sizes



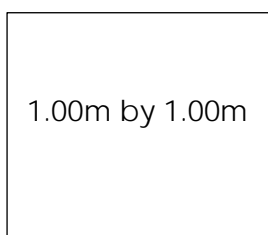
Can be made in flannelette or muslin.



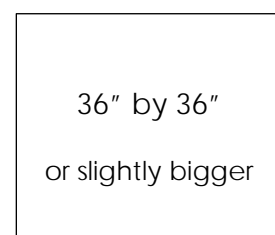
Can be made in cotton knit, polar fleece or cotton, in neutral colours only.



## Blanket sizes



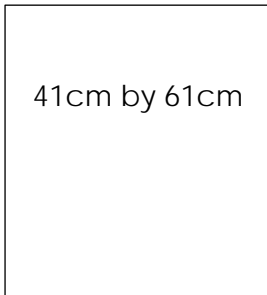
Can be made in fleece, polar fleece or crochet.

## Patchwork Quilts (humidicrib covers)



Use soft pastel colours or white only.  
Do not use dark colours for backing quilts.  
Thin (85 gram) wadding required.
