Tiny Premmie Gown

Materials

- 50cm length of material - cotton interlock with good stretch - makes 3 complete gowns and hats.
- Also need approx. 60cm of purchased ribbon per gown for the closure of 30cm each side.
- Button / pom-pom / self-fabric loop to trim hat.
- Cut 3cm wide strips along stretch of fabric for bindings to all edged and sleeves.

Instruction

1. Right sides together, stitch front to back at shoulder seams and top of sleeves.
2. Fold edge binding strip in half-length ways wrong sides together and pin across width.
3. Open out stitched shoulder seam flat. Pin folded edge strip to front-right sides together - 3 cut edges together and stitch. Hem of back and sleeve ends in the same way.
4. Press all sewn seams out flat and bindings.
5. Right sides together. Pin tie ribbons in position just under curve underarm. Stitch side seams from cuff to hem catching tie ribbon in seam. Press seam flat.
6. Tie bow in the ribbons across front to close.
